Title of case study (and priority ranking)	Ideas about good elder care at the municipal level
Country/region/place investigated	Denmark/5 municipalities (among these, two high and two low spending)
Social service sector(s) investigated <i>(Erase non relevant ones)</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Older people 	Huge differences in the provision of elder care exists among Danish municipalities. Municipalities spend between between about €3350 (lowest spending) and €8220 (highest spending) per elder (+65) per year. The dynamics behind these differences will be investigated. Expecially, it will be analysed whether differences in spending is associated with different ideas as to what good elder care is all about.

Interviews will focus on: what is good care and how is elder care organized accordingly? About 10 interviews in each municipality has already been conducted.
