Title of case study (and priority ranking)	Restructuring of care for older people in Jyväskylä
Country/region/place investigated	Finland
Social service sector(s) investigated (Erase non relevant ones)  Older people	Care service systems for older people and their governance have in Finland been under major change and restructuring during the last two decades, the main trends including stricter targetting, outsourcing of municipal services, encouragement of purchase of private services (through vouchers and tax deductions) and integration of family carers with the formal care service system. Local authorities are in the center of these changes as they are responsible for governance of the new mixed economy of care at the local level, being largely free from central regulation. This case study will study these trends in the context of one local authority, the city of Jyväskylä, providing thus an illustrative case analysis of the restructuration process. The paper will be finished by discussion on what can be concluded on the character and trends of the restructuration of care and how governance models are adapting to these changes.
