 Social service sector(s) investigated (Erase non relevant ones) Older people People with disabilities (possibly including mental health) 	Malta's community care social care services have grown slowly in parallel with GDP growth. But the dependent population is expected to soon grow dramatically with ageing. The social as opposed to the health side of community long-term care will be challenged in the near future.

Gender	Basically this will be an effort to assess and improve quality by way of improved carer support and supportive networks, to improve input in both quantity (of volunteers and other services) and quality (introducing and expanding good practices).
