	This program aims to build instruments to prevent and to create social communication in order to combat abuse of the elderly.
	The case is innovative because there is no instrument or program for it, unlike what happens in the prevention of abuse of children and women.
	This is an example of multi-scalar cooperation: a) bi-level with public-public partnership between Local municipal administration and county council; b) between these public administrations and private sector with the participation of two associations ( EIMA, Consejo de personas mayores del Solsonès y Asociación de Mujeres del Solsonès); and c) horizontal participation in the territory, with the participation of seven services and local organizations and c) Centro sanitario, Policía Local, Policía Autonómica. Servicios de Información a la mujer, servicios sociales, Consejo de Personas Mayores del Solsonès) all members of the County Council (Consejo Comarcal).
	The program develops:
