Five 'perspectives' (Erase non relevant ones)  Social and/or territorial cohesion  Gender  Cost efficiency/quality/user satisfaction	This research aims at identifying the heterogeneous circumstances and experiencies within the low-income population using ECEC. Exploring the different needs of these families will show under what conditions ECEC services can actually help to reduce child poverty.
	Indirectly, this study could shed light on the impact that the obstacles to access to ECEC services might have on gender inequalities within the different fractions of the low-income families.
	These research will explore diverging definitions of "quality" in ECEC services that may emerge from the discurses of the different actors involved.
Three processes in restructuring + crisis (Erase non relevant ones) • Cuts/rationalization/management reforms (NPM, others) • Vertical subsidiarity (administrative rearrangements between government levels)	The case study is carried out in a context where cuts in ECEC and other social policies have been recently carried out. These cuts may undermine the inclusive dimension of ECEC services.  The study will explore how cuts carried out by regional authorities are implemented in the local context shaping the inclusive dimension of ECEC services.
